## Poway stroke survivor receives scholarship to play in golf tourney

Walt Kough of Poway has been selected to receive a scholarship to play in the San Diego Brain Injury Foundation Charity Golf Classic to be held April 30 at the StoneRidge Country Club in Poway. The scholarship is awarded by the Don Strom SDBIF Golf Scholarship Fund, which is funded by donations from SAE fraternity brothers of brain injury survivor Don Strom of Rancho Bernardo.

Kough, a brain injury survivor, was selected because of his love of golf and his active volunteerism in the San Diego Brain Injury Foundation. In 2001, he suffered a massive heart attack and five weeks later, a stroke. He is partially paralyzed with some loss of vision. Prior to

his stroke, Kough played golf four days a week and was a golf team captain at the StoneRidge Country Club. In the past year, he has begun to play golf again.

Players are needed for the 22nd annual SDBIF Charity Golf Classic. The \$275 registration fee includes golf, lunch, dinner, prizes, contests, raffles, live and silent auctions and a chance to win \$100,000 and a car. Proceeds will benefit SDBIF, which was founded in 1983 to improve the quality of life for brain injury survivors and their families.
